MAX. NUMBER OF PIECES & DISPLAY REQUIREMENTS

Type of Artwork: Original work preferred, Giclees and Limited Editions will be accepted (need to be clearly identified). All types of art mediums will be accepted (e.g. paintings, woodwork, ceramics, sculptures, jewelry, textile and photography, etc.)

Two dimensional works - four (4) pieces

2-dimensional work to be ready to hang on metal grids using "S" shaped hooks (i.e. paintings, prints, photographs, quilt, etc.). **Unframed work** will be accepted, however, these pieces need to be gallery wrapped (2" - 3"), no unfinished edges.

Three dimensional work – four (4) pieces

3-dimensional work should be ready to be displayed on tables or pedestals (i.e. ceramics, woodwork, sculpture or other artwork that can be displayed on a table or pedestal)

Miniature work – eight (8) pieces

Small decorative items less than 3" x 3" (i.e. pens/writing implements, handmade cards, or other easily portable artwork that can be displayed in an **artist provided case** or on a table.

Jewelry – 50 pieces

Jewelry pieces that can be displayed in an artist provided case, table or tabletop display item. For security reasons, jewelry artists must provide their own volunteer to "man" their table and sell their pieces.
