## Eric Wiegardt Workshop

April 26-29, 2022 9AM-2PM each day

**Format:** 2 days classroom, 2 days plein air (subject to change and weather permitting)

Downtown Art Center is tentatively booked as the classroom setting.

**Registration:** HWS Members \$675, non-members \$700. 50% deposit reserves your seat. Balance due March 10. This workshop is limited to 15 participants to ensure that each person receives individual attention.

Eric's workshops are designed to loosen up even the tightest painter and break the niggling detail habit. Painting loose is much more than a technique. It requires an understanding of specific design concepts in order to free one's mind. Each day, Eric will focus on one of these principles. He will show how to construct a beautiful painting in one sitting, and free creative thinking from cumbersome theories of color and composition. There will be time for individual instruction in a relaxed atmosphere. A variety of subjects will be painted which may include landscapes, marinescapes, florals, streetscapes and still life.
